

ORDINANCE NO. 4060

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, MISSOURI AMENDING SECTION 18-3 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO COURT COSTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Section 18-3, Court Costs, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Clinton is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 18-3. Court costs.

(a) Court costs shall be in the amount as set forth in subsection (b) hereof for each case of a violation of this Code or any city ordinance violation filed before the municipal judge. If the defendant pleads guilty or is found guilty, the municipal judge shall assess the aforementioned costs against the defendant, except in cases where the defendant is found by the municipal judge to be indigent and unable to pay. These costs are in addition to service costs, witness fees and jail costs that may otherwise be authorized to be assessed, but are in lieu of other court of judge costs or fees.

(b) Court costs shall be as follows:

Clerk fee, \$12.00, or the amount otherwise provided for under Section 479.260 RSMo and as the same may be hereafter amended. The municipal court may order a portion of this amount placed into judicial training funds or appointed counsel funds as allowed under Section 479.260 RSMo.

CVCF surcharge (Crime Victim's Compensation Fund), \$7.50, or the amount otherwise provided for under Section 595.045 RSMo, and as the same may be hereafter amended.

POST surcharge (Peace Officer Standards and Training fund), \$1.00, or the amount otherwise provide for in Section 488.5336 RSMo, and as the same may be hereafter amended.

LETf surcharge (Law Enforcement Training Fund), \$2.00, or the amount otherwise provided for in Section 488.5336 RSMo, and as the same may be hereafter amended.

Domestic violence shelter fee, \$4.00, or the amount otherwise provided for in Section 488.607 RSMo and as the same may be hereafter amended.

Court automation fee, \$3.00, or other amount as provided for in Section 476.056 RSMO and as the same may be hereafter amended.

Section Two. It is intended that the provisions of Section One of this Ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances of the City of Clinton.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
