

ORDINANCE NO. 4076

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 42 OF THE CLINTON CITY CODE REGARDING THE COMPOST FACILITY AND APPROVING FEES TO ALLOW COMMERCIAL LAWN CARE SERVICES TO USE THE COMPOST FACILITY.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the City Council of Clinton, Missouri that

1. Sec. 42-28 of the Clinton City Code is hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

Sec. 42-28. - Composting facility.

- (a) The composting facility shall receive only grass clippings, leaves, limbs (less than 4 in. in diameter), brush, garden vegetation and similar yard wastes that originate from properties within the city limits of Clinton
 - (b) Commercial lawn care services must obtain a permit/vehicle tags and pay the required fee in order to use the composting facility. Sec. 42-28 (a) is applicable to commercial lawn care services.
 - (c) Failure to comply with 42-28 (a) and (b) is unlawful and will result in fines and loss of privileges.
 - (d) Commercial permits shall commence on October 1 of each year and shall expire on September 30 of the year following the date of issuance. The amount collected for a permit issued after April, shall be prorated by 50 percent as to the amount due for an entire 12-month period.
 - (e) A commercial lawn care service is any person or business receiving remuneration for providing lawn care services.
2. The City of Clinton Fee Schedule, as approved by Ordinance 4067, is hereby amended to include the following fees:

COMPOST SITE

Commercial permit fee


1-3 employees	\$500, includes 1 vehicle tag
4-20 employees	\$1,000, includes 2 vehicle tags
21-50 employees	\$2,500, includes 3 vehicle tags
51 or more employees	\$5,000, includes 4 vehicle tags
Each additional commercial lawn care service vehicle tag: \$5 each	

3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
4. City staff are instructed to take appropriate administrative action to implement the items included in this ordinance.
5. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


