

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-2022**


**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, MISSOURI APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE RECREATIONAL TRAILS GRANT PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton is applying for federal assistance from the Recreational Trails Grant Program for the purpose of constructing the City of Clinton Walking Trail Project;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF CLINTON, THAT:

1. Mayor Greg Lowe, of the City of Clinton, is authorized to sign the application for federal assistance and any other official project documents that are necessary to obtain such assistance, including any agreements, contracts or other documents that are required by the State of Missouri, the Federal Highway Administration or the federal Highway Trust Fund.
2. The City of Clinton currently has the written commitment for the minimum 20% matching share for the project elements that are identified in the application and will allocate the funds to complete the project.
3. In the event a grant is awarded, the City of Clinton will commit the necessary financial resources to operate and maintain the completed project in a safe and attractive manner for public access in perpetuity.
4. In the event a grant is awarded, the City of Clinton is prepared to complete the project within the time period identified on the signed project agreement.
5. In the event a grant is awarded, the City of Clinton will comply with all rules and regulations of the Recreational Trails Grant Program, applicable Executive Orders and all federal and state laws that govern the grant applicant during the performance of the project.
