**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CLINTON ADOPTING THE 2024 HENRY COUNTY MULTIJURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS** the City of Clinton has participated in the preparation of a multi-jurisdictional local hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the 2024 Henry County Multijurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, hereafter referred to as the Plan, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

**WHEREAS** the Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the City of Clinton from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and




**WHEREAS** adoption by the City of Clinton demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Plan.
