

RESOLUTION NO. 10-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, MISSOURI (CITY) AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) GRANT THROUGH THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (MoDOT).

WHEREAS, MoDOT accepts applications for TAP grants, which provide funding for eligible activities; and

WHEREAS, the City has planned a 3-phase project identified as the Second Street Sidewalk Extension Project; and

WHEREAS, Phase I of the 3-phase project will consist of the design and construction of new sidewalks along the eastside of Second Street, from Hillcrest Drive to Gaines Drive, and the installation of ADA traffic signal upgrades at the intersection of MO Hwy. 7 and MO Hwy. 13; and


WHEREAS, if approved, the grant will fund a maximum of \$448,240 of the estimated project costs of \$560,300;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City commits to providing a local match of \$112,060 for Phase I.

Section 3. The City Administrator are hereby authorized to submit a TAP grant application for Phase I of the Second Street Sidewalk Extension Project.
